

## Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries

In this scheme Fisheries Department is providing 60% subsidy to the Fish Farmer for Excavation, Renovation and Inputs. The main of the scheme is to increase the fish production and to double the income of the Fish Farmers.
